

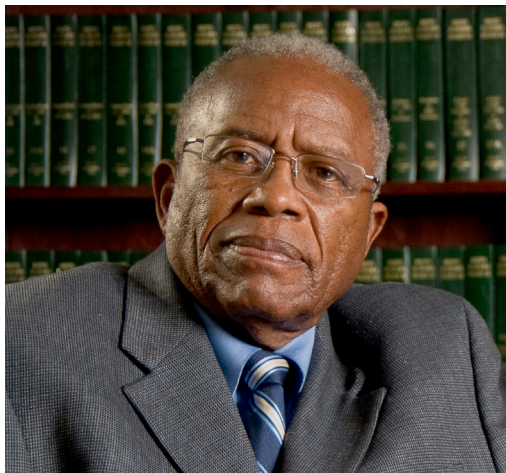

### **Fred Gray, Civil Rights Attorney**

A native of Montgomery, Ala., and an alumnus of Alabama State University ('51), Gray is one of the nation's most respected and accomplished civil rights lawyers. His legal career spans more than six decades and includes having represented Rosa Parks after her December 1955 arrest for refusing to give up her seat on a bus to a white man, an act that ignited the historic Montgomery Bus Boycott.
